What is a Skills to Shine Enterprise Club?

Through the Enterprise Club young people will work on real life business challenges and gain new knowledge. They will be working with different business mentors and taking part in various engaging workshops before putting their new found knowledge into practice at a business launch event.

What are the benefits of taking part in a Skills to Shine Enterprise Club? The Enterprise Club will focus on enterprise and entrepreneurial skills development that enhance participant's key skills such as: teamwork, communication, confidence, leadership and creativity. The soft skills the young people will gain will be transferable to adult life out in the world of work.

Key Features of our Enterprise Club include:

- Project based learning approach which develops enquiry based learning techniques

Who is the Enterprise Club for?

The Skills to Shine Enterprise Club is open to students from 8-16 years that wish to develop their leadership and entrepreneurial skills through fun and exciting enterprise challenges.

What will it cost?

The Skills to Shine Enterprise Club will cost 1950 AED for each block of two weeks per student.
